Organized in 1970, CHSRA District 3 is open to all High School students as well as the Junior Division for students in 6th through 8th grade. All members must maintain a 2.0 GPA and a passing grade in all subjects. They must also provide and care for their own horse(s) and pay for their travel expenses and entry fees.

District 3, known as the **Thundering Three**, has approximately 150 members and for the last few years has been the largest of the nine districts. District 3 has competitors from Yuba, Nevada, Placer, Sutter, Yolo, Solano, Sacramento, El Dorado and Sierra Counties. CHSRA goal is to keep alive our Western Heritage and the American Cowboy and Cowgirl way of life: sportsmanship, honesty, hard work, teamwork, loyalty, personal pride, stewardship of livestock and love for our country.

CHSRA is a strong family orientated program. The rodeos are held at the Lincoln Horseman's Arena just south of Lincoln on Highway 65. Rodeos are held on Saturday and Sunday from 8:00am until around 3:00pm. Check the website at www.CHSRADistrict3.com for rodeo dates. There is no charge to attend.
